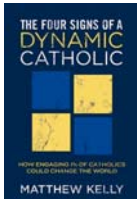

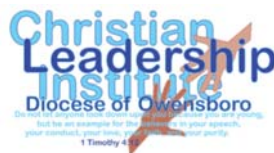

The cost for the diocesan package this year is \$485.00 per person. This cost includes the conference registration fee, housing for three nights, transportation (via coaches), breakfast, lunch on Thursday, snacks each night after the conference, t-shirt or hoodie, insurance, night security at the hotel and give-away items. **It DOES NOT include the cost of 5 meals. You can bring snacks or extra money for snacks along the way.**

We plan to leave on Wednesday, November 15th and will load the buses after the closing liturgy on Saturday evening and return home. A more precise timeline will follow.

If you are interested in going we must reserve spots on the bus by the end of this month. In order to reserve a spot you must pay the \$100 non-refundable deposit by **no later than JUNE 23**. 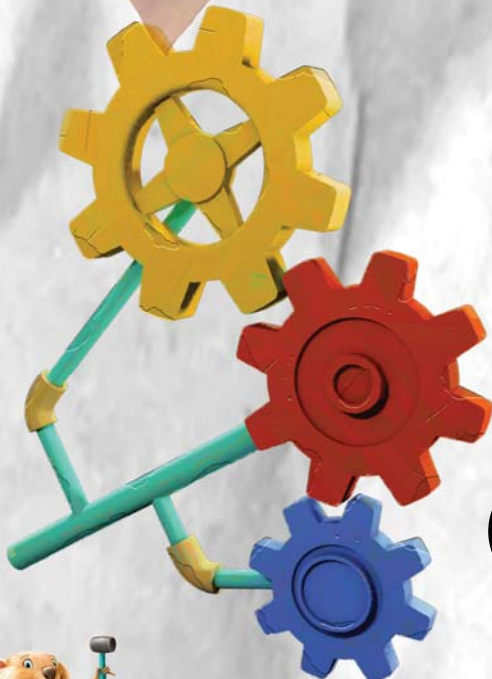
